Minutes:

CHIEF'S REPORT:

Chief Drolet reports the following statistics for the July 2020:

Budget Chief Drolet reports that there is 40.03% remaining in the department budget and 70.31% remaining in ACO budget. He states that the 2021 budget must be submitted to the town administrator by 9/22. He will provide a draft budget to the commissioners at September meeting.

Purchase Order:

Chief Drolet states there is one purchase order for review and signature: Axion \$7200 which is for TASER 7 (year 2) payment.

Cruisers:

Chief Drolet reports that Car 2 light bar issued has been addressed by using an old one for now that was in the garage – which is a temporary solution. Chief Drolet reports that the new cruiser has not been ordered yet by Ford and he states that it may be winter before it arrives. He adds that it will go to Two-Way and that may be delayed as many towns will be getting their new vehicles once they are available.

Building: Chief Drolet reports that the Public Safety Complex Strategy Committee met recently. He adds that he has attended the last 3 meetings. He notes that he is an advisory member only along with Fire Chief Tetreault and Emergency Management Director Robert Young. Chief Drolet reports that the generator at the station is not working. He had J&D Power look at it. It will not be repaired due to age/condition. He adds that he has one that can be used if necessary until another one is purchased. He has contacted the facilities committee to see if funds are available for replacement.

New Business:

1. Chief Drolet reports that a vehicle went into Johnson's Restaurant building near the outside pavilion area. Drugs and alcohol do not appear to be a factor. Some injuries were sustained in the collision.
2. Chief Drolet reports there were drugs seized as a result of a motor vehicle stop and included both drugs and cash.
3. Chief Drolet reports they have been addressing a number of homeless encampments that are located in various areas of Northwood.
