

## Polling Place Campaigning / Electioneering Rules

For Northwood, NH

1. Campaign signs must be physically held by a person.
2. Campaign signs are not allowed to be free standing.
3. People holding signs and all portions of their signs must remain behind the cones / markers used to designate ways of egress.
4. Campaigners must at all times maintain a clear passage for voters and vehicular traffic
5. Signs and the people holding signs cannot impede voters traveling from the parking area to polls in any way.
6. Campaigners may not interact with the voters unless they come to you. Campaigners may not call out to voters or try to hand them items / materials.
7. No campaign materials (signs, shirts, buttons, flyers, etc.) may be displayed in any part or in any manner within the polling area.
8. Campaigners may not hand out self-adhesive stickers for write-in candidates. The labels may damage the ballot machine. And since the labels are not considered official ballot materials, they will not be recognized as a legal vote.
