

## Safety Facilities Strategy Committee 6/17/20

Call to order at 6:03 PM

- Met at Narrows Facility
  - Fire chief conducted tour
  - Not large for current equipment
  - Inadequate storage for gear, med supplies, & misc. supplies for daily functions
  - Very tight office space
  - Only two small bunk rooms
  - No meeting space at facility
  - No exhaust venting in fire equipment bay
  - Discussed previous consideration of enlarging narrows Warrant article, volunteer effort required
  - Discussed could new building be built on adjacent lot
  - Both chiefs suggest two fire stations may be necessary keeping Narrows station
- Police Station
  - Chief conducted tour
  - Limit parking
  - Lobby to small
  - Not sound separation in rooms
  - Six officers in one office
  - Four officer in second
  - Chief has own office
  - Small evidence, gun locker and booking area
  - One bathroom
  - Traffic on RT 4 hazardous at station
  - Separation of arrestee's security issue
- Ridge Station
  - Equipment cramped in station and dangerously close to RT 4
  - Medical supplies storage inadequate
  - Emergency Management center at ridge station will have to be accommodated in future facility
  - Possibility of accommodating future town functions
