- Initial approach
 - Accessing the current status of facilities
 - Do current facilities satisfy town needs
 - Will they meet future needs
 - If not what are possible solution
 - Entire replacement
 - Upgrade current facilities
- Elected officer
 - Hal Chair Joe Vice Chair
- Hal suggested targeting committee conclusion for 2021 town voting 2022
 - Further discussion of holistic approach as a starting point to develop a hierarchy of requirements with respect to state regulation and law
 - Separate must have function vs “like to have”
- Several members suggested brainstorming as a way to evaluated info
- It was further suggested a mission statement defining Stack holders and requirements
- Chief Droulet pointed out previous work had been on initial Safety Complex that the Town voted down
- All agreed important to review previous proposal
