Final minutes for August 15, 2022 meeting

The meeting, held at the Northwood Community Center, was called to order at 6:30 PM.

Old Business

Update on sales of swag:

Sandy reported \$300 in sales on 8/13/22 at the softball tournament and \$700 at the transfer station on 7/30/22 for a total of \$1000 in sales.

Cookbook update – Pat reported she received 68 recipes. She has sent the rough draft to the printer. Pat has a volunteer, Diane Heller, who will draw clipart. There was a discussion on what should appear on the cover. It was suggested that Pat decide on a design and present it to the group at a future meeting. She will get costs of various options from the printer. It was also suggested to sprinkle historical pictures throughout the cookbook. The cookbook will be dedicated to Joann Bailey.

Printed program - A lengthy discussion occurred. Options are for 1) one program for anniversary, bean hole bash and softball tournament combined, 2) a separate program for each event in #1 or 3) each business being given the option of deciding in which program their ads would appear. A decision will be made at a future meeting.

Pop up store update – Sandy will ask permission to set up a booth at the September primary on 9/13/22. Judy will coordinate volunteers to sell items for this date. We will sell items at the transfer station on Sunday 8/28/22. Lisha is coordinating volunteers for this date.

Yardsticks – Judy brought a sample and presented details on pricing. They could be made for under \$6.00 and sold for \$10.00. She will get more detailed information before a decision is made.

Continue work on scheduling events – No new changes made.

New Business

It was suggested to make a sub-committee for publicity.

A fireworks exploratory committee will be formed. Wade Sauls and Judy volunteered. They will check with the fire department for rules, safety guidelines, etc.
