Draft minutes for August 21, 2023 meeting

The meeting, held at the Community Center, was called to order at 6:40 PM.

Roll call - Attendees: Sandy Priolo, Irene Kreider, Isil Kenyon, Conan Kenyon, Lisha Nelson, Judy Martin-Royce, Pat Vaillancourt, and Jo Chase

Lisha made a motion to accept the minutes from 7/24/23. Judy seconded the motion. It passed on a voice vote.

Old Business

Sandy reported that the selectboard wants a breakdown of what swag remains and a financial statement.

Lisha made a motion to spend a maximum of \$200.00 for a plaque for the time capsule and items that will be placed in it. Irene seconded it. It passed on a voice vote.

Jo made a motion to reimburse Lisha for misc. expenses of \$230.26. Pat seconded the motion. It passed on a voice vote.

The town has not yet received the bill for the bus shuttle service. The final cost was \$865.00.

Sandy created a photo album of events on 7/29/23. The photos were taken from the video made by Lakes Region Public Access.

Judy spent \$220.31 on signage for parking. These signs were donated to the Recreation Department for their use.

Also, the small spot lights that were purchased for use in the pavilion on 7/28/23 were donated to the Recreation Department.

General updates

Fairview, Canterbury, Harvey Lake, Ridge, East End and Pine Grove cemeteries will be part of the cemetery tours in October. The Historical Society is working on this. It will be self-guided tours and will take place over 2-3 weeks.

Lisha presented an idea of doing a Northwood/NH history trivia night at Johnsons as an additional activity, possibly in the fall. She proposed that the 250th committee pay for appetizers. It was suggested that participants register in advance. It was suggested to plan to have this after the cemetery tour. Conan made a motion for Lisha to make contacts and start working on details. Isil seconded it. It passed on a voice vote.

Writing thank you notes- The list of those to thank was reviewed and discussed. Lisha made a motion that we spend up to \$150 for postage, thank you cards, and ink for Sandy to print out cards. Conan seconded it. It passed on a voice vote. It was decided to meet on Wed. 8/30/23 at the Community Center to write all the notes.

Judy suggested giving businesses that we used a positive review on Google.

Sandy will contact Scott Blewitt about having a swag table at the fall craft fair.
